Arundell ineligible for England after committing to Racing 92

Henry Arundell will be ineligible for England until June 2026 after his contract extension with Racing 52 was confirmed. Arundell has made a flying start to life in Paris and has signed with Stuart Lancaster's club for another two seasons, ruling him out of Steve Borthwick's plans. The 21-year-old's decision to commit to Racing is a hammer blow for the English Rugby Football Union, who hoped to make him the poster boy of the "hybrid" contracts that will be introduced next season.

Arundell had the chance to join Bath, with the RFU topping up his salary as one of 25 players over whom Borthwick will be able to exercise greater control, but has chosen to continue learning his craft under Lancaster instead. Arundell joined Racing after the World Cup following the demise of London Irish last summer. Initially he had expected to be available for the coming Six Nations hut Borthwick will now not unable to pick one of English rugby's most exciting talents.
